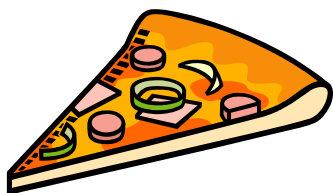
Dick and Donovan worked on a bagging job for Colby Metal. Shelly worked on sealing them.

Free Lunch

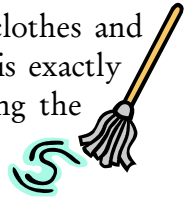
